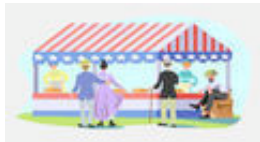

This festival features four days of celebrating Mexican culture and paying homage to the dead - including Michael Jackson. It's a unique way to "travel" to Mexico and attend the traditional celebration hosted by Mano a Mano: Mexican Culture Without Borders.
